Who am I? (Restoration in Christ)

Below are some questions that could help us all reflect on today's sermon and to go deeper with God during our quiet time this week.



John 3:18 He that believes on him (Jesus) is not condemned: but he that believes not is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

- In what area of my life do I lack fulfillment?
