





# THE RESURRECTION OF JESUS

- **The most attested fact in history**
  - At least one of them



# THE CROSS

- **The superficial answer: Jesus died on the cross for our sins**
- **Today's topic: What Jesus actually offers to all of us, by His death and resurrection**



# SIN AND RIGHTEOUSNESS

- Jesus gets our sin
- We get Jesus' righteousness


*For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him (2. Cor. 5:21)*



# CURSES AND BLESSINGS

- Jesus gets the curse of the law
- We get the blessings of Abraham

*Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, “Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree”), that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith. (Gal. 3:13)*




# IDENTITY

- **Jesus was forsaken as a son**
- **We become children of God**

*And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, “Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani?” that is, “My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me? (Matt. 27:46)*


*But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name (John 1:12)*



# FELLOWSHIP

- Jesus was rejected by God
- We can now be in fellowship with God again

*That which we have seen and heard we declare to you, that you also may have fellowship with us; and truly our fellowship is with the Father and with His Son Jesus Christ. And these things we write to you that your joy may be full. (1. John 1:3-4)*




# SICKNESS AND HEALING

- Jesus gets our sicknesses
- We get His healing


*(Jesus) who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed. (1. Peter 2:24)*

*Rom 7:15: For what I am doing, I do not understand. For what I will to do, that I do not practice; but what I hate, that I do.*




# ABUNDANT LIFE

# THE RESURRECTION


- The cross without the resurrection is worthless



# LOVE


- **The cross is the greatest expression of love in the history of mankind**

*Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends.*




# ALL OR NOTHING
