The Narrow Gate

Matthew 7:24-25 Therefore whosoever hears these sayings of mine, and does them, I will liken him unto a wise man, who built his house upon a rock: And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock.

Below are some questions that can help us all go deeper with God during our quiet time this week

- Is „obedience“ and „integrity“ something that really describes my Christian walk? Or would „compromises“ describe my life better?
- What effect does my lifestyle have on other people? In the church? In my workplace? In my family? In my circle of influence? Am I „bearing good fruit“ towards others?
- In this season of my life, would I say that my obedience yesterday encourages me to obey again today? Or would I say that my disobedience yesterday encourages me to disobey today? What trajectory is my life on?
- Am I really dealing with and owning my sin? Or do I usually show other ways of „trying to deal with my sin“?
- When was the last time I allowed God to speak my identity over me? Do I want to ask Him to do it (again)?
