REPENTANCE = EVIDENCE OF FAITH

1 John 3:1-3 Behold, what manner of love the Father has bestowed upon us, that we should be called the children of God: therefore the world knows us not, because it knew him not. Beloved, now are we the children of God, and it does not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is. <u>And every man that has this hope in him purifies himself, even as he is pure</u>.



REPENTANCE = EVIDENCE OF FAITH




AFFECTIONS

VICTORY OVER SIN


Romans 6:5-8 For if we have been united with him in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection: Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that we should no longer serve sin. For he that is dead is freed from sin. Now if we are dead with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him:

MURDER

Matthew 5:21-22 You have heard that it was said by them of old time, You shall not kill; and whosoever shall kill shall be in danger of the judgment: But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, You fool, shall be in danger of hell fire.

Matthew 5:28 But I say unto you, That whosoever looks on a woman to lust after her has committed adultery with her already in his heart.


GOD'S LAW

Psalms 119:15-16 I will meditate in your precepts, and have respect unto your ways. I will delight myself in your statutes: I will not forget your word.


