Luke 7:47 Therefore I say unto you, Her sins, which are many, are forgiven; for she loved much: but to whom little is forgiven, the same loves little.

Below are some questions that can help us all go deeper with God during our quiet time this week

- Can I wholeheartedly say that I am currently leading a „repentant lifestyle“? Why or why not?
- How is my current prayer life? Do I see a connection between my prayer life and my current practice of repentance?
- Is „confessing sin to others“ something I do regularly? Why or why not?
- What is my experience with the connection between „love“ and „repentance“ throughout my Christian life? Am I currently in a season of „lots of repentance and lots of love“? Or rather the opposite?
- Is my repentance mainly focused on my current problems? Or is it mainly focused on the eternal impact it has?
- What is holding me back from repenting more?
- Now that this series is coming to an end: How does God want me to change in the way I practice repentance?
