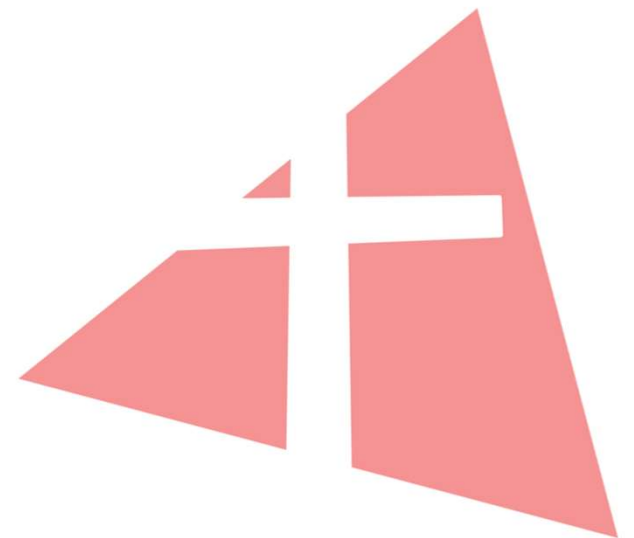

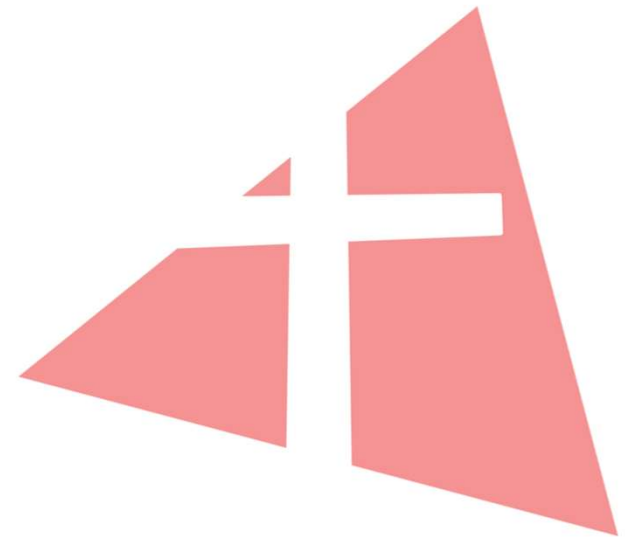
SHORT EASTER SERIES

- **Monday: Boldness in Christ**



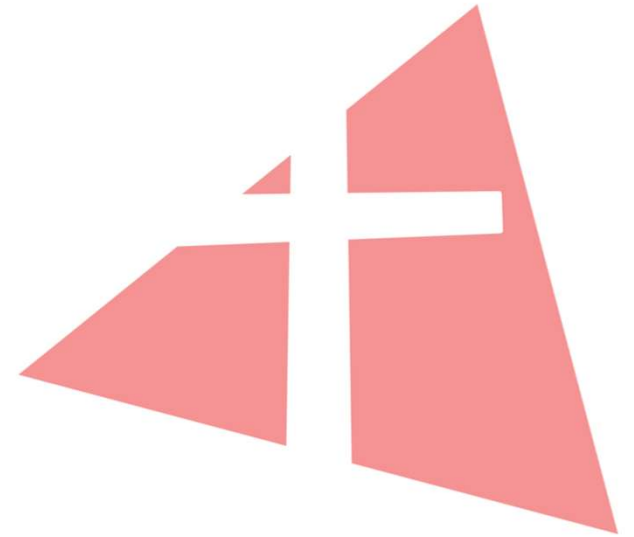
SATURDAY

 - Jesus was not yet resurrected



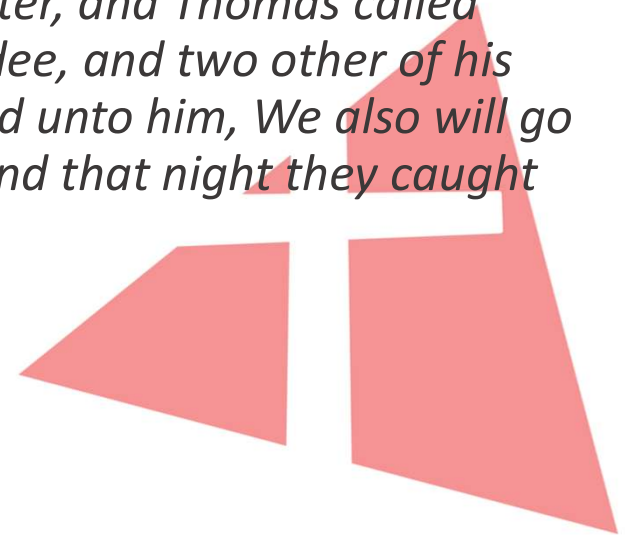
SATURDAY

- On this day, everything seemed lost



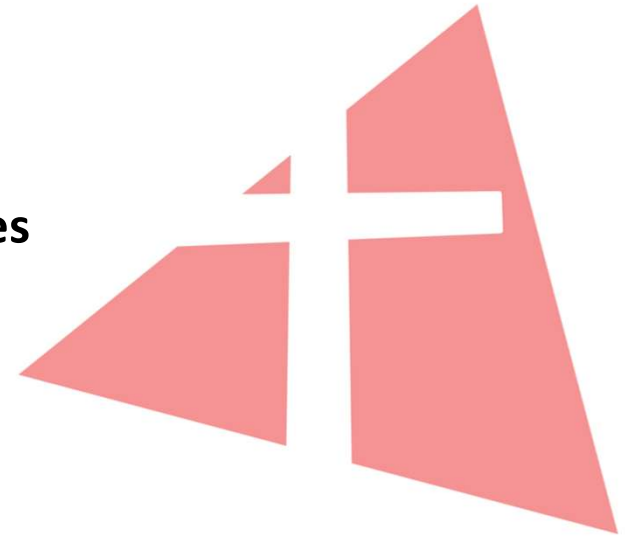
SATURDAY

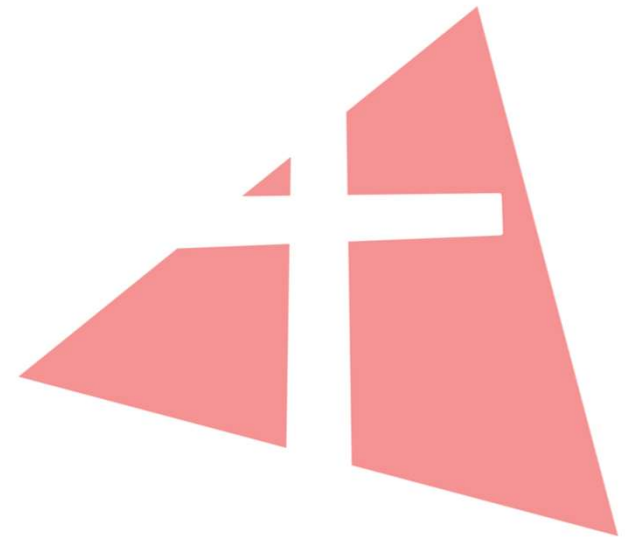
SATURDAY

SATURDAY FOR US

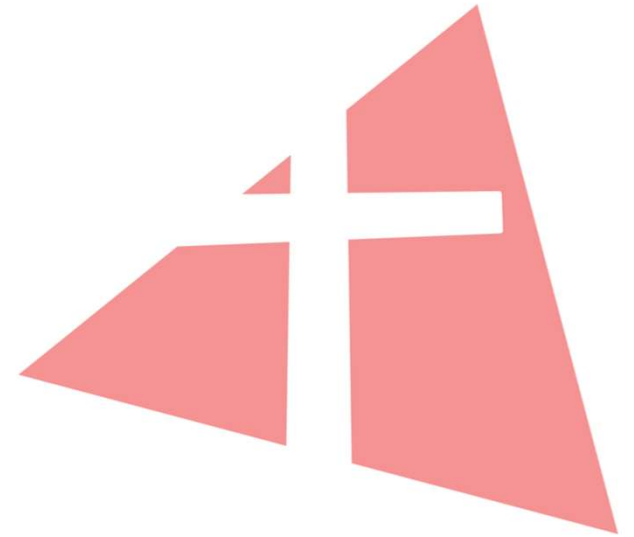
- **We are living on Saturday when ...**

SATURDAY FOR US

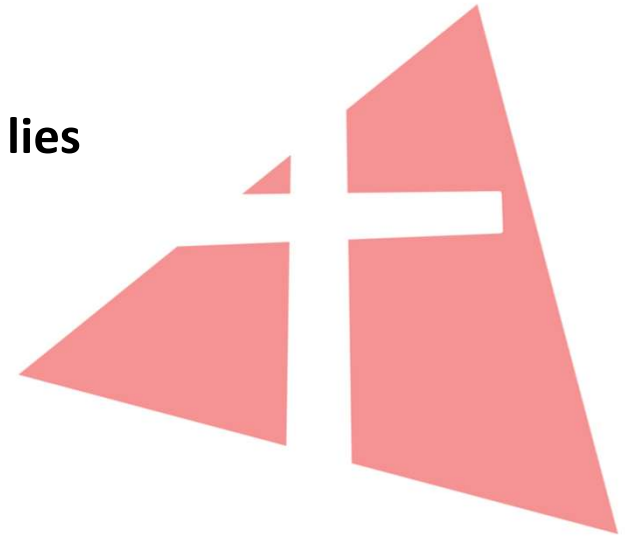
○ What part of our live do we live on Saturday rather than on Sunday?

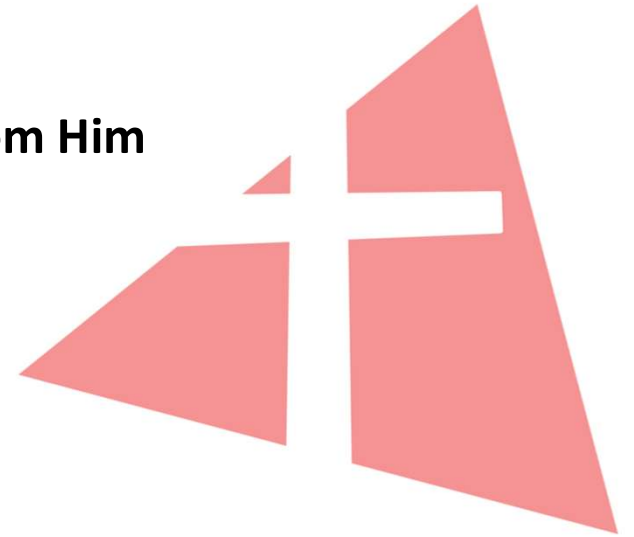
SEASONS OF SATURDAY
