## *God's Power*

**Romans 8:11** *But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also bring to life your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwells in you.*

Below are some questions that can help us all go deeper with God during our quiet time this week

- Do I still struggle with people who hurt me? What can I learn from Jesus' example in Gethsemane on how to get over my hurts and disappointments?
- What part of my life feels like a „Saturday Season“ right now?
- How have Saturday seasons impacted my life in the past? Positive? Negative? Both? Do I want to meditate on a specific season of Saturday and how it has affected me?
- Do I see God's power as something that is available to me today? Or more like something that was available in the past/will be available in the future again, but not today? Why?
- In what area of my life do I currently experience God's power? In what area does it feel more like I'm missing God's power?
- If I had to choose one specific area in which I want to experience God's power: Which one would I choose?
- Do I come boldly to God, as the book of Hebrews is telling us to do? Why or why not?
