



JESUS' TEMPTATION

Matthew 4:1-11 Then was Jesus led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. And when he had fasted forty days and forty nights, he was afterward hungry. And when the tempter came to him, he said, If you are the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread. But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God. Then the devil took him up into the holy city, and set him on a pinnacle of the temple, And said unto him, If you are the Son of God, cast yourself down: for it is written, He shall give his angels charge concerning you: and in their hands they shall bear you up, lest at any time you dash your foot against a stone. Jesus said unto him, It is written again, You shall not test the Lord your God. Again, the devil took him up into an exceedingly high mountain, and showed him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them; And said unto him, All these things will I give you, if you will fall down and worship me. Then said Jesus unto him, Begone, Satan: for it is written, You shall worship the Lord your God, and him only shall you serve. Then the devil left him, and, behold, angels came and ministered unto him.


THE CONTEXT

Matthew 4:2 And when he had fasted forty days and forty nights, he was afterward hungry.




1ST TEMPTATION

 - Even legitimate needs




2ND TEMPTATION

• Requiring proof




2ND TEMPTATION


3RD TEMPTATION

APPLICATION


• The devil tempts us by promising to fulfill God's promises here and now

• We just have to step out of God's ways




NOTICE THE DIFFERENCE
