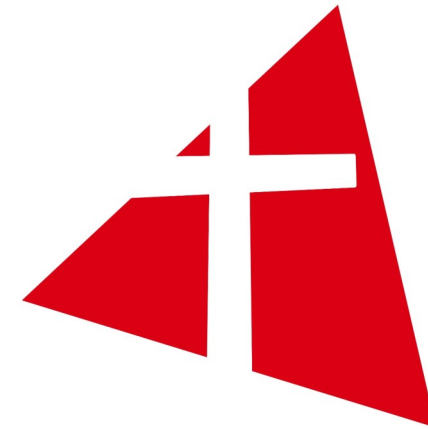

A Christmas of Hope or a Christmas of Covid? ?

Matthew 1:23 Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us.

Below are some questions that can help us all go deeper with God during our quiet time this week

- What have I done the last few years for Christmas? Was it a time when I focused on my relationship with God? Or was it a time when I mainly focused on myself and the things that I wanted to do?
- How do I currently see the Covid-19 situation? Am I scared, worried and frustrated like most other people? Or can I rest in God's promises and experience His peace and joy? What does that say about my Faith?
- What impact does Jesus' name „Emmanuel“ have on my life today?
- What impact do God's promises from Psalm 91 have on my life today?
- What role does God's Faithfulness play in the way I live my life?
- What impact does Jesus' teaching on the end times have on how I see the Covid-19 situation?
- Given the lockdown we are facing: How can I make the most of this Christmas BECAUSE OF the circumstances we are living in?
