## *I'm Smart! (Am I?)*

*Luke 10:20 Nevertheless in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.*

Below are some questions that can help us all go deeper with God during our quiet time this week

- What story from Luke 9—10 speaks can I relate to the most? When did I live just like the disciples lived? What was the result?
