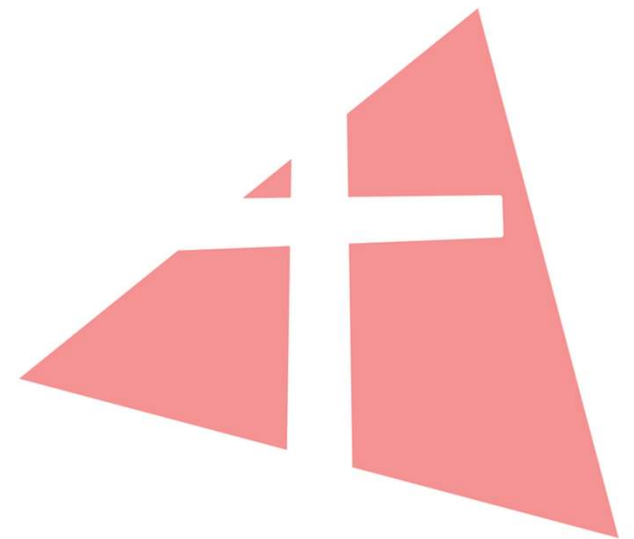


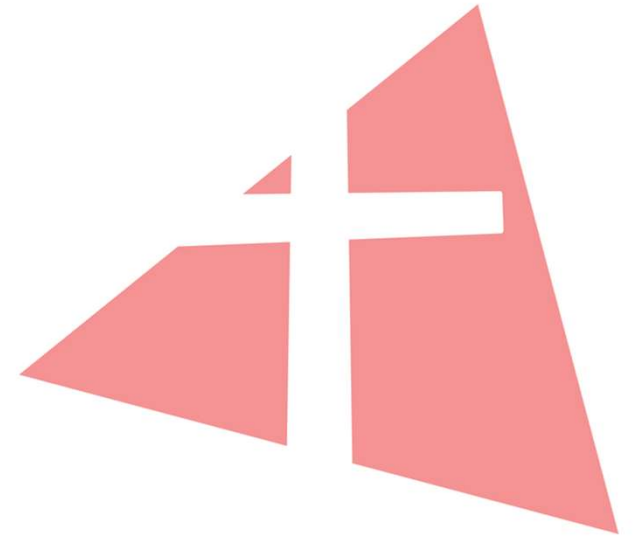

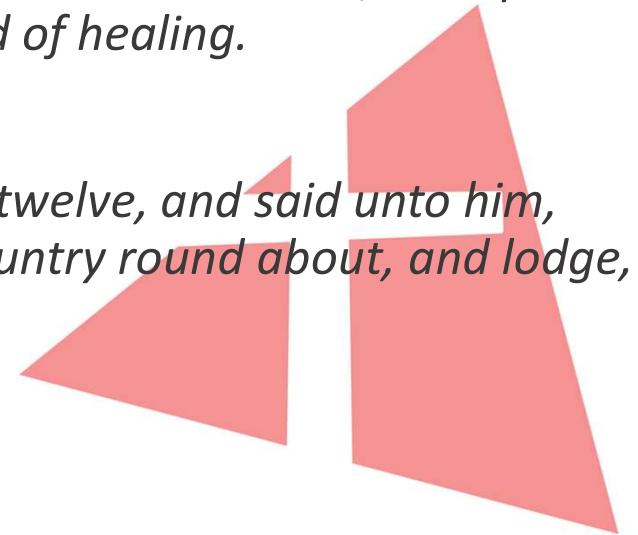


# THE FEEDING OF THE 5000

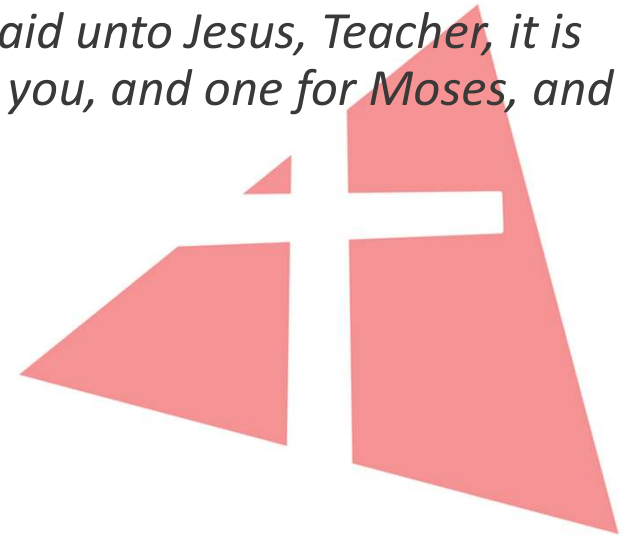
# THE FEEDING OF THE 5000

# THE TRANSFIGURATION

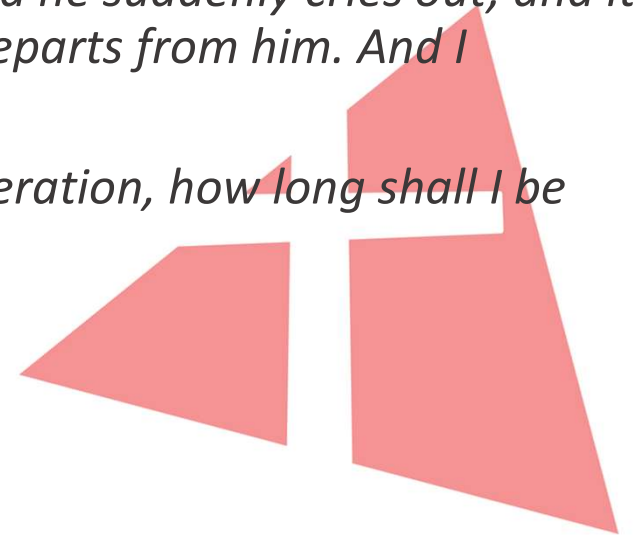

**Luke 9:50** *And Jesus said unto him, Forbid him not: for he that is not against us is for us.*

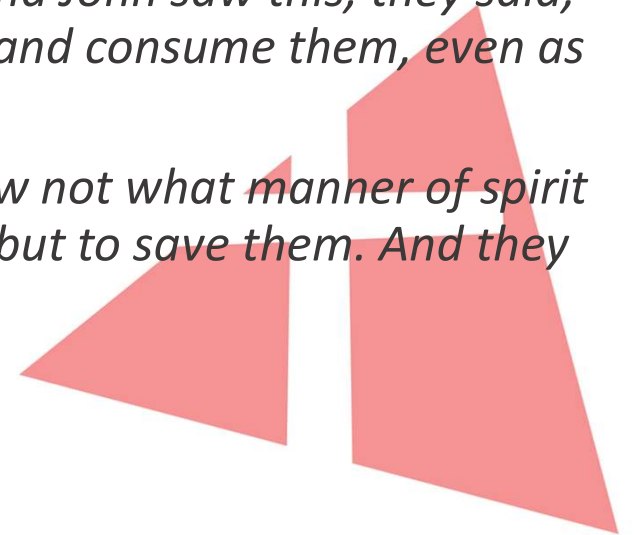




# THE SAMARITANS

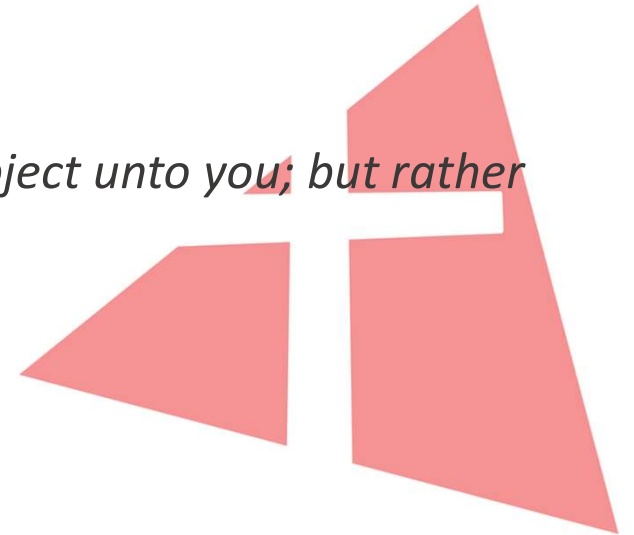


# SENDING OUT THE 70

**Luke 10:17** *And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the demons are subject unto us through your name.*

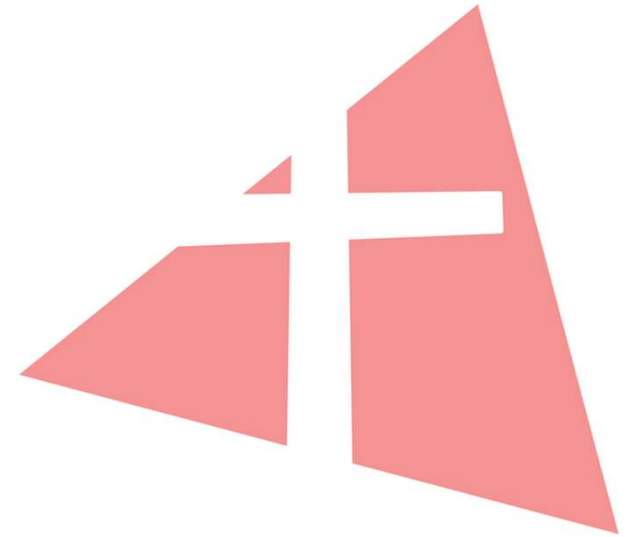

**Luke 10:20** *Nevertheless in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.*



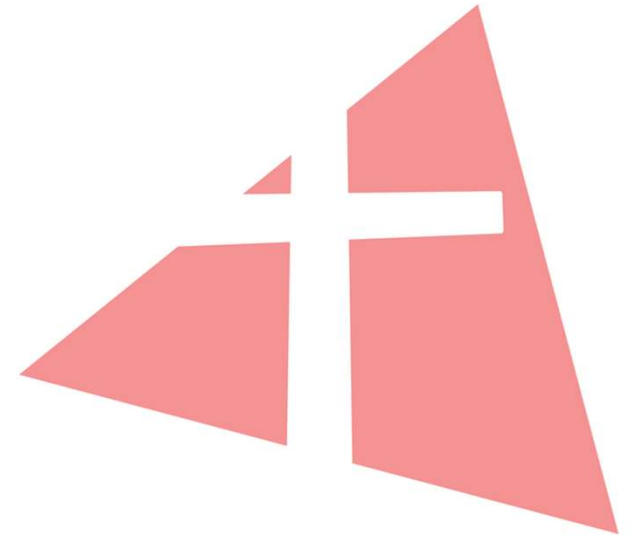
# LUKE 9 - 10

- The disciples used “their own ways” over and over again



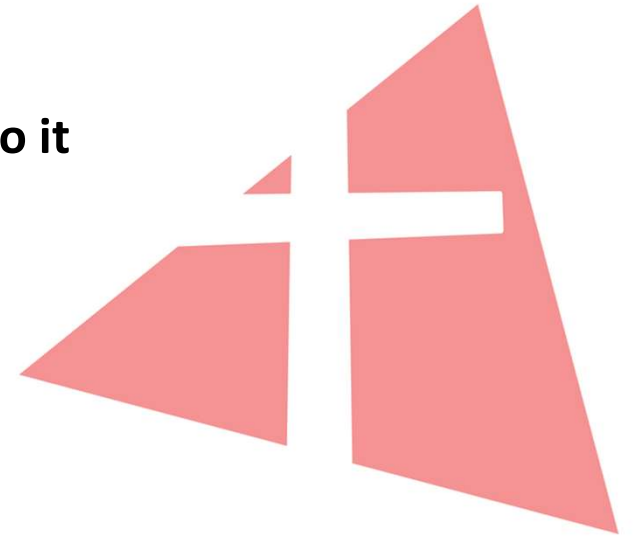
# THE DISCIPLES' WAYS

- What if they had gotten their way?



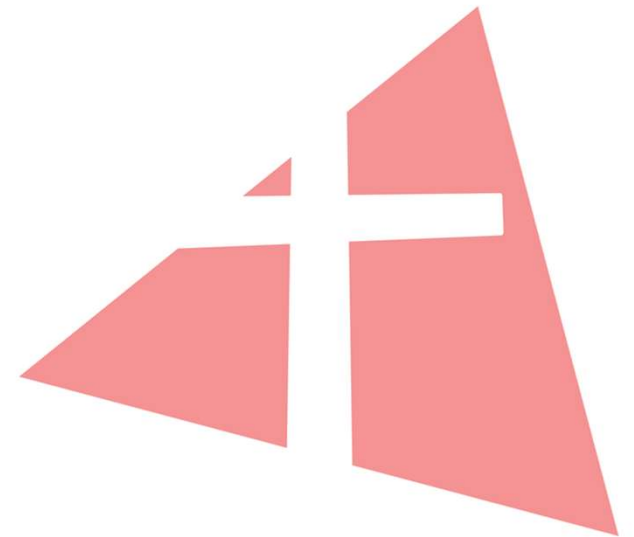
# THE DISCIPLES VS. ABRAHAM AND SARAH
