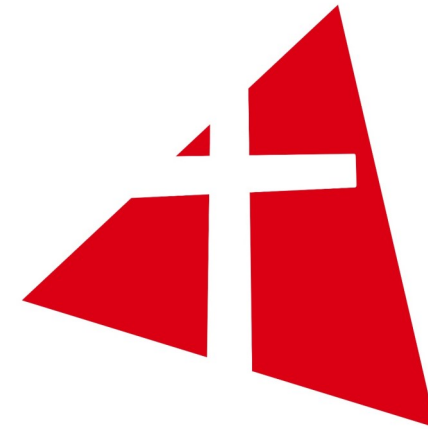

The foolishness of this world

Matthew 11:25 ... I thank you, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hid these things from the wise and prudent, and have revealed them unto babes.
