

Come Boldly!

Hebrews 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

Below are some questions that can help us all go deeper with God during our quiet time this week

- Would I say that I currently come boldly into God's presence? Or am I coming with fear instead of boldly? Or am I not coming at all? Why?
- How does the story of the Israelites from Exodus to Deuteronomy apply to my Faith today? Do I see this story as a story of „me and God“? Or do I treat it more as a story of other people and God?
- Would I say that I am currently truly resting in God's presence? Or is my life better described as working and striving? What does this say about my Faith?
- Do I live as if Jesus already did ALL the work? Or do I feel that I still have to „complete Jesus' works“?
- Does my life really reflect the reality of receiving all mercy and grace from God? Or does my lifestyle seem to communicate something else?
