## *Our childhood: Receiving Healing*

*Psalm 139:23-24 Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts: And see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.*

Below are some questions that can help us all go deeper with God during our quiet time this week

- Am I truly honest to myself about myself? Or are there things I try to avoid or not think about?
- Is it part of my Christian walk to allow God to examine my heart and reveal my heart to me? Does God want me to do this more often?
- Can my relationship with God be described as a „Father-child relationship“ ? Or are there other types of relationships that would describe the current state of my relationship with God better?
- Are there areas in my life where I try to deal with the symptom of the issue more than with the root issue itself?
- Does God want me to establish more boundaries with my parents? In what area?
- Is there someone I am currently talking to about my childhood wounds? If not: Who can I ask to listen to and pray with me?
