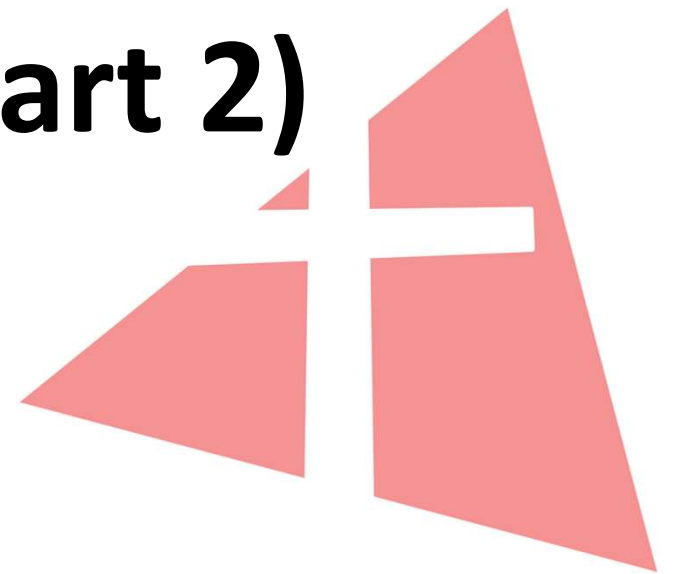

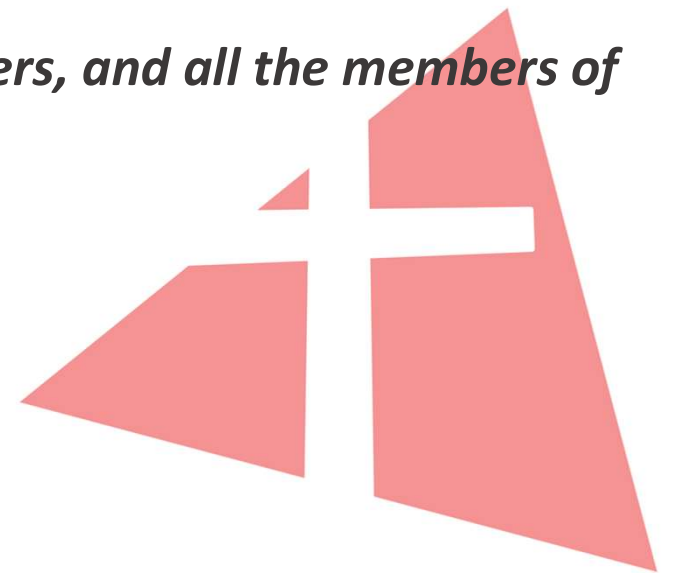

1 Corinthians 12:12 For as the body is one, and has many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ.



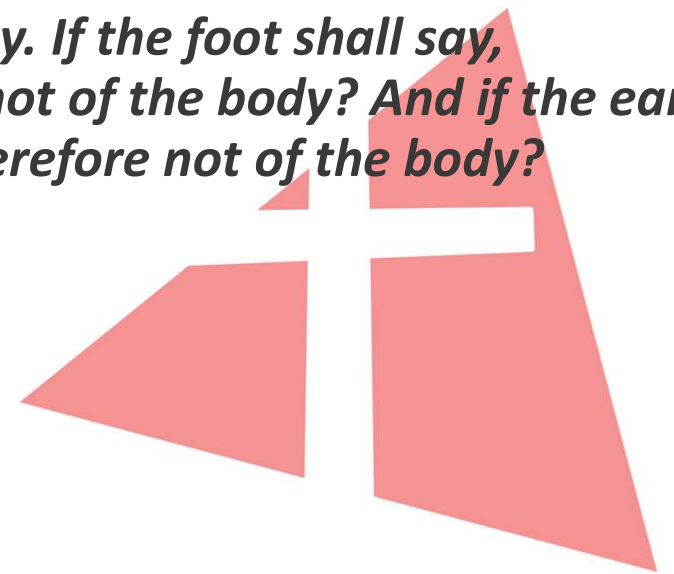
Earthly differences

1 Corinthians 12:13 For by one Spirit were we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.



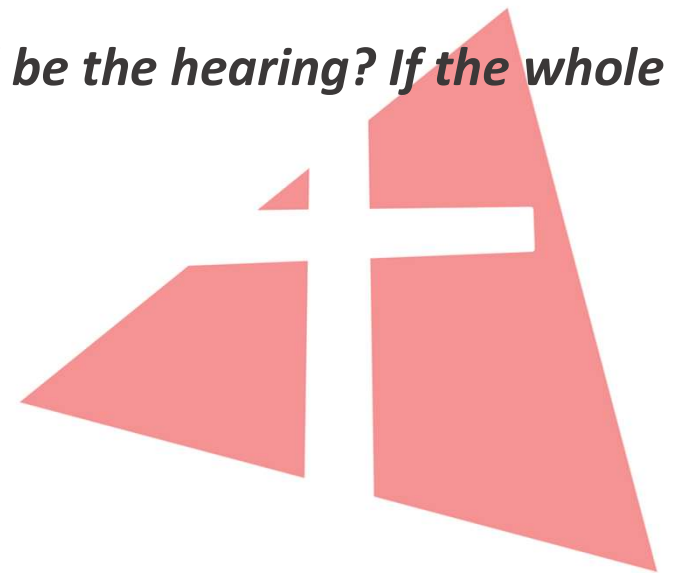
Don't feel excluded

1 Corinthians 12:14-16 For the body is not one member, but many. If the foot shall say, Because I am not the hand, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body? And if the ear shall say, Because I am not the eye, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?



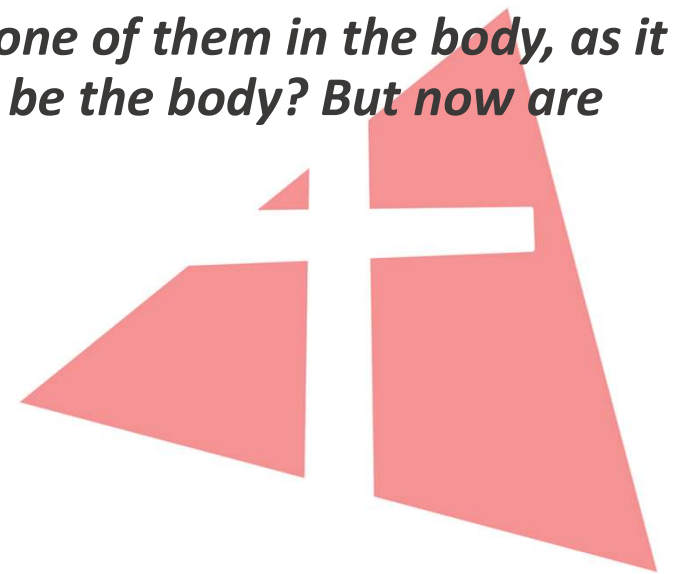
Being like others

1 Corinthians 12:17 If the whole body were an eye, where would be the hearing? If the whole were hearing, where would be the smelling?



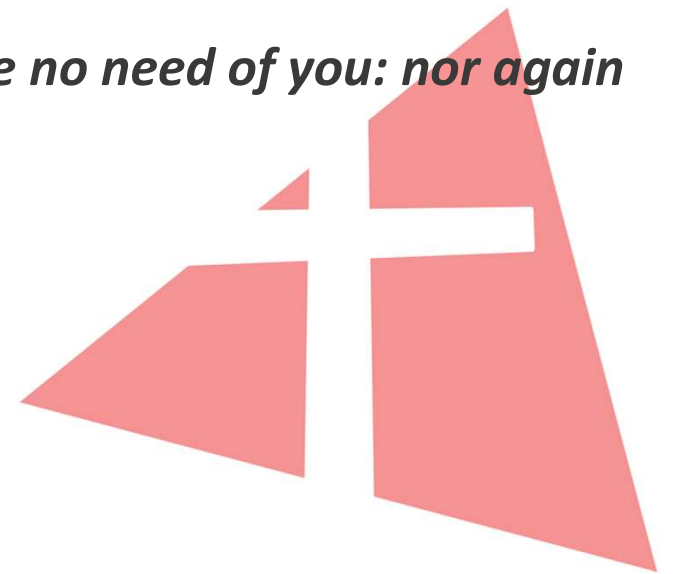
God's Plan

1 Corinthians 12:18-20 But now has God set the members every one of them in the body, as it has pleased him. And if they were all one member, where would be the body? But now are they many members, yet but one body.



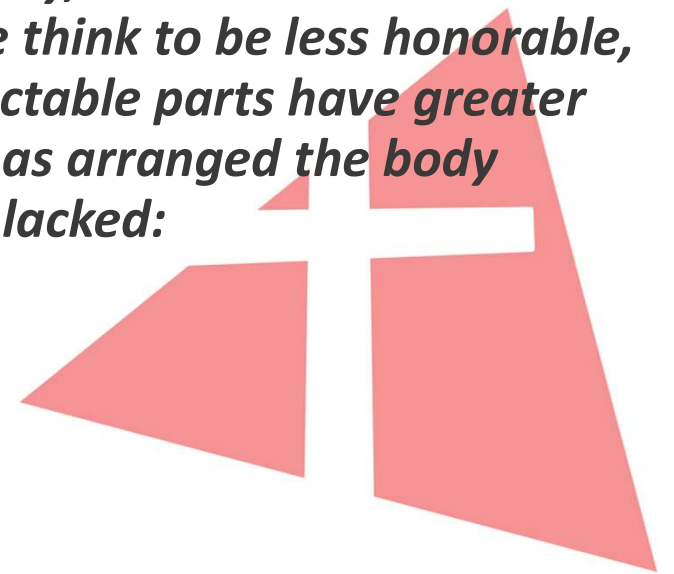
Pride

1 Corinthians 12:21 And the eye cannot say unto the hand, I have no need of you: nor again the head to the feet, I have no need of you.



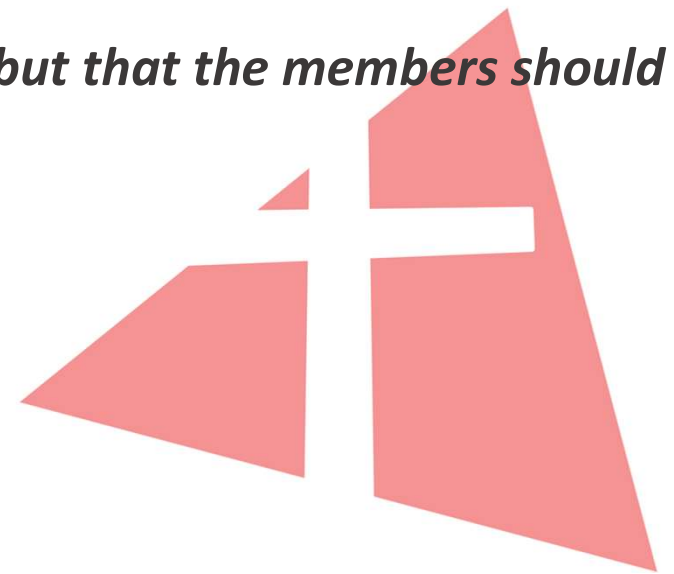
Honoring the less honorable

1 Corinthians 12:22-24 Nay, much more those members of the body, which seem to be more feeble, are necessary: And those members of the body, which we think to be less honorable, upon these we bestow more abundant honor; and our less respectable parts have greater respect. For our more respectable parts have no need: but God has arranged the body together, having given more abundant honor to that part which lacked:



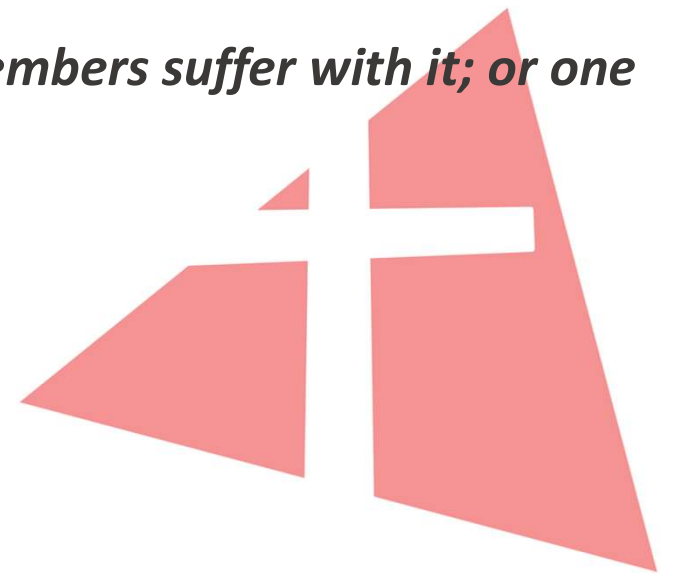
Honoring the less honorable

1 Corinthians 12:25 That there should be no schism in the body; but that the members should have the same care one for another.



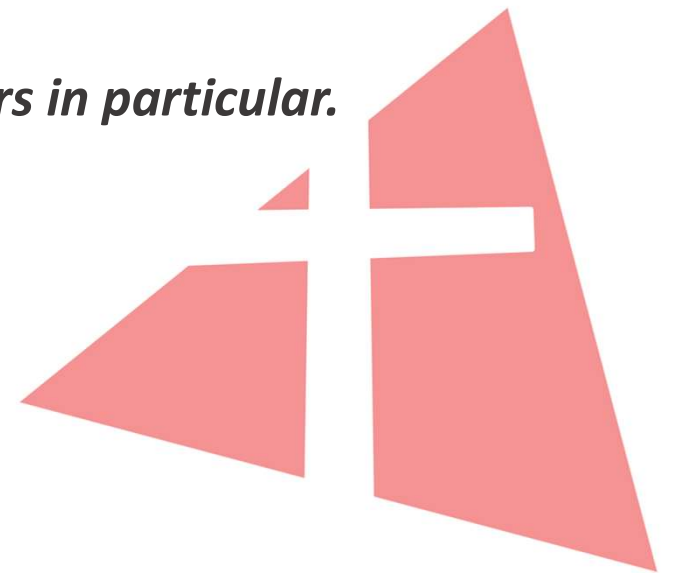
Care for the Body

1 Corinthians 12:26 And whether one member suffers, all the members suffer with it; or one member be honored, all the members rejoice with it.



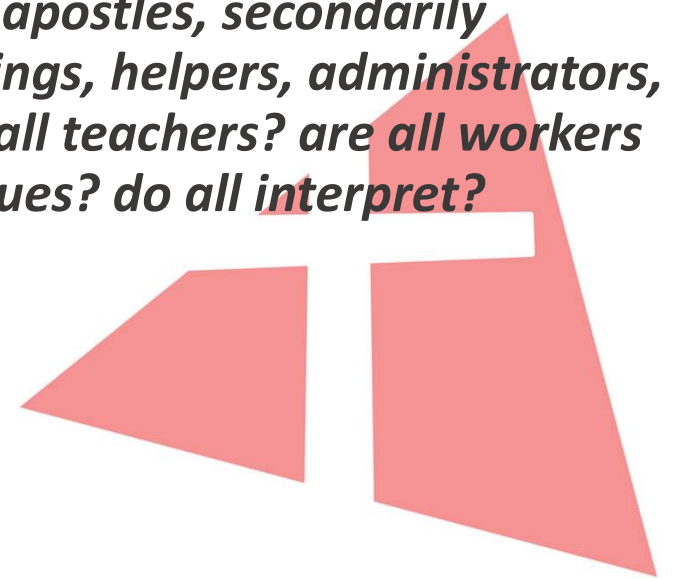
Members of His Body

1 Corinthians 12:27 Now you are the body of Christ, and members in particular.



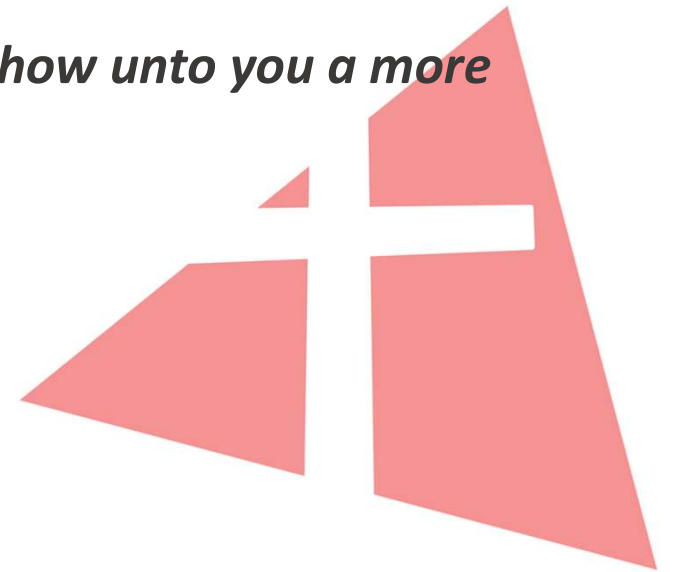
Roles in the church

1 Corinthians 12:28-30 And God has set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helpers, administrators, various kinds of tongues. Are all apostles? are all prophets? are all teachers? are all workers of miracles? Have all the gifts of healing? do all speak with tongues? do all interpret?
