 - Be thankful for what is already available to us as Christians

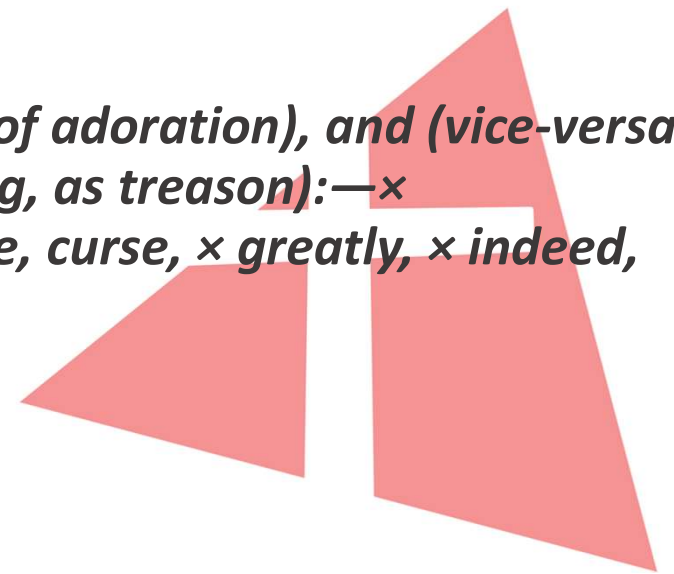


Bless the Lord

Psalm 103:1-2 Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name. Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits:

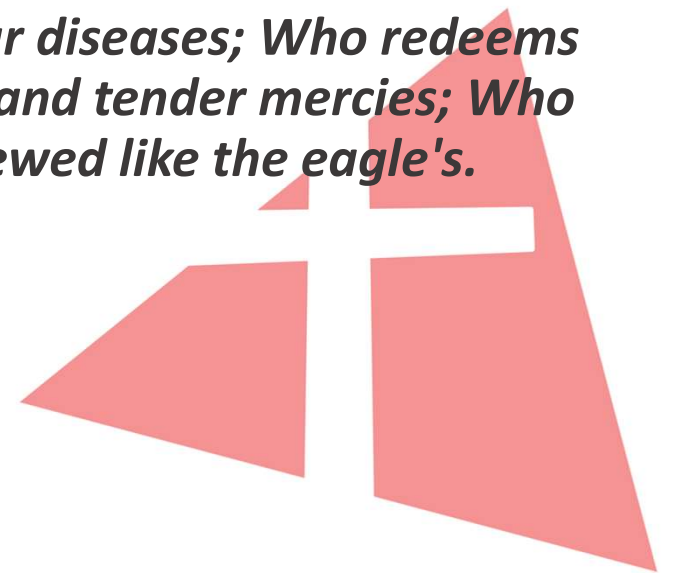
בָּרַךְ bâarak, baw-rak'

a primitive root; to kneel; by implication to bless God (as an act of adoration), and (vice-versa) man (as a benefit); also (by euphemism) to curse (God or the king, as treason):—× abundantly, × altogether, × at all, blaspheme, bless, congratulate, curse, × greatly, × indeed, kneel (down), praise, salute, × still, thank.



Things to bless God for

Psalm 103:3-5 Who forgives all your iniquities; who heals all your diseases; Who redeems your life from destruction; who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies; Who satisfies your mouth with good things; so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.



Justice

Psalm 103:6-7 The LORD executes righteousness and justice for all that are oppressed. He made known his ways unto Moses, his acts unto the children of Israel.



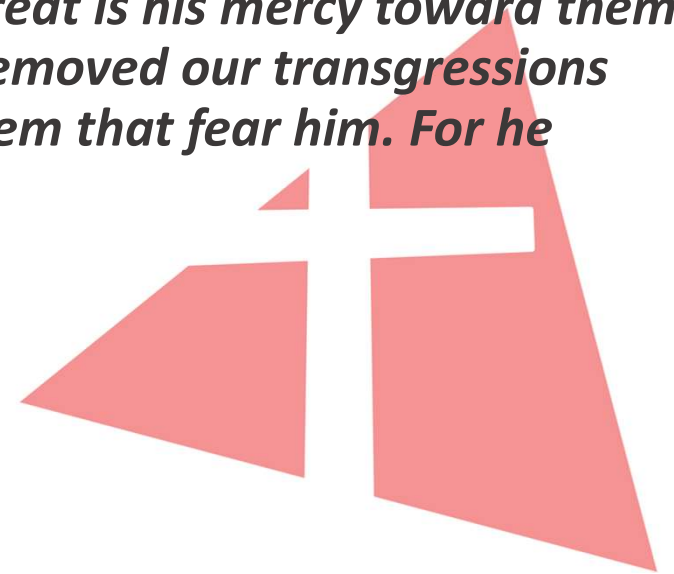
God's Character

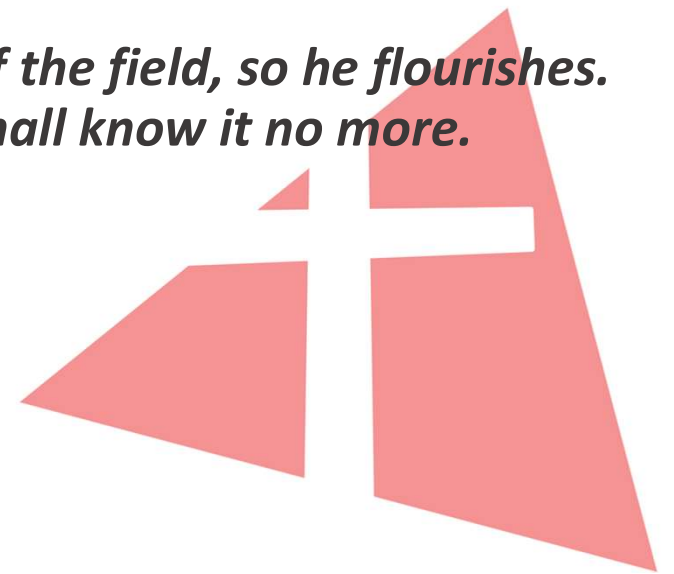
God's Character

Psalm 103:15-16 As for man, his days are as grass: as a flower of the field, so he flourishes. For the wind passes over it, and it is gone; and the place there shall know it no more.



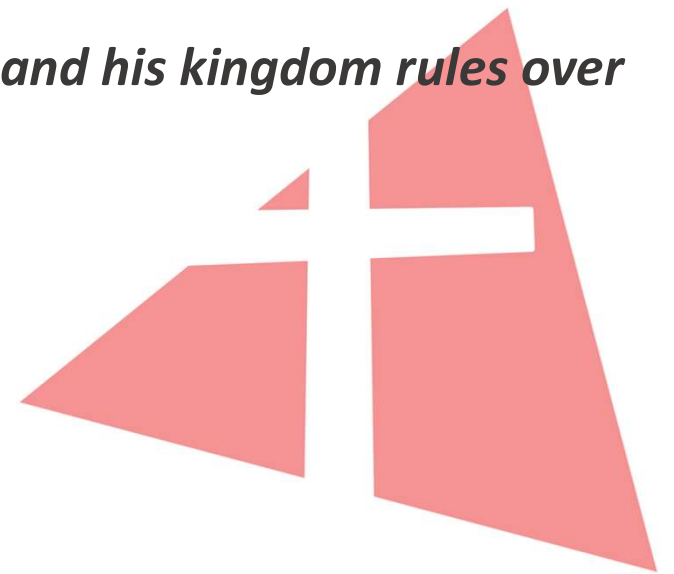
God's Mercy

Psalm 103:19 The LORD has prepared his throne in the heavens; and his kingdom rules over all.



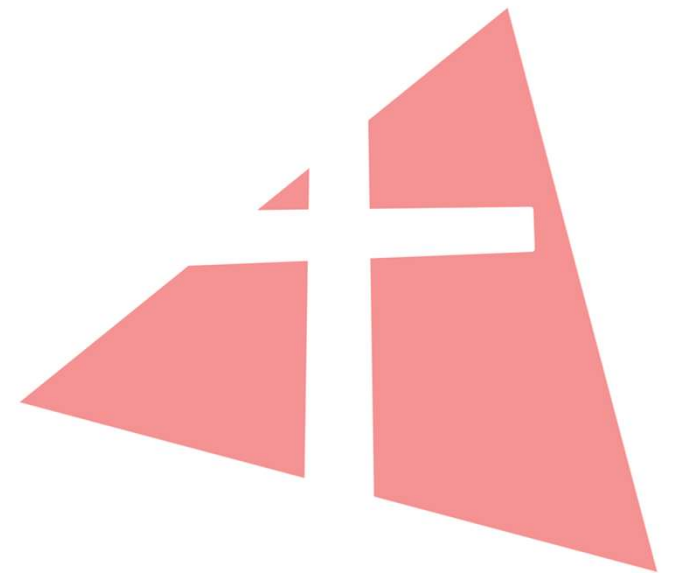
Blessing God together

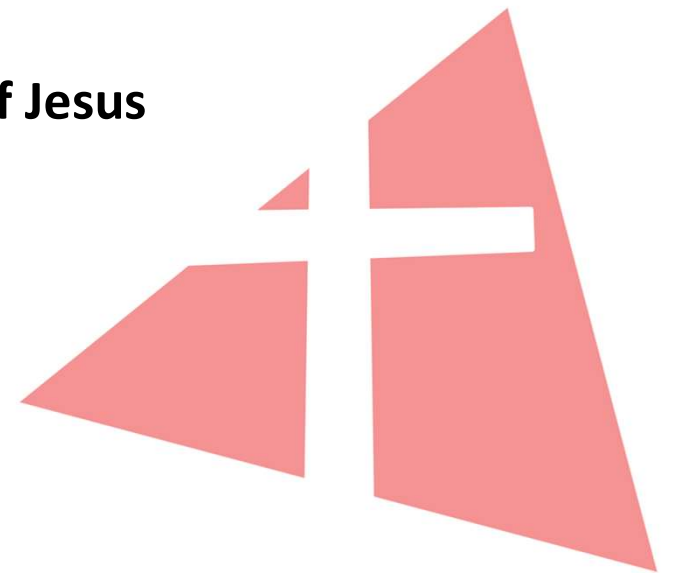
David's Message
