Encountering God: God's Discipline

Hebrews 12:6 For whom the Lord loves he chastens, and scourges every son whom he receives.

Below are some questions that can help us all go deeper with God during our quiet time this week

- What is my general attitude towards God's discipline? Do I see it as something positive? Or do I generally try to ignore/reject God's discipline?
- Is there any kind of confusion between discipline and punishment in my heart?
 Do I sometimes think God is punishing me? What kind of follow-up lies do I believe because I believe God is punishing me?
- What kind of discipline did I receive in my childhood? From my parents? From other people in authority? Did I perceive it as discipline or punishment? How do these experiences affect my view of God's discipline today?
- In what area of my life is God trying to discipline me right now? Do I respond to God's discipline in a way that brings Glory to Him?
