Outreach: Sharing the Gospel

2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

Below are some questions that can help us all go deeper with God during our quiet time this week

- Before today's service: How would I have summarized the gospel? Now looking back: Was there any essential part missing in the way I would have described the gospel?
- In my own personal life: Is there a part of the gospel that seems less real/ relevant to me? How does God want to strengthen this aspect in my own life?
- In my past: Which of these elements did I put less emphasis on when sharing the gospel? Which part should be strengthened?
- Have I ever indirectly put pressure on a person on "what they have to do to be a real Christian"? How did that turn out?
- Who does God want me to share the gospel with next?
- Who does God want me to invite to our weekend with Claire?
