


Luke 2:14 Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.



Hope


Romans 8:18 For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.





Christmas should be a time to receive Jesus' Joy in a fresh way




Our Struggle
