




The Immediate Consequence of Sin

Genesis 3:7-8 (KJ2000) And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons. And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden.

God's Purpose

God's Intend

- God created us for His Glory
- God created us as His Children
- God created us to grow into a marriage relationship
- Now Adam and Eve were afraid of God



God created us to rule and do good works

We lost our authority

John 12:31 Now is the judgment of this world: now shall the prince of this world be cast out.

Luke 4:5-6 (KJ2000) And the devil, taking him up into a high mountain, showed unto him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. And the devil said unto him, All this power will I give you, and the glory of them: for that is delivered unto me; and to whomsoever I will I give it.

God created us for community

Their relationship with each other broke

Genesis 3:7 And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons.

Genesis 3:12 And the man said, The woman whom you gave to be with me, she gave me of the tree, and I did eat.

God created us in His image

- Adam and Eve now had a sinful nature
- They had children in their own likeness instead of God's

Galatians 5:17 For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that you cannot do the things that you would.

Genesis 5:3 And Adam lived a hundred and thirty years, and begat a son in his own likeness, after his image; and called his name Seth:

God created us for Meaningful Work

Genesis 3:19 In the sweat of your face shall you eat bread, till you return unto the ground;...


God gave Adam and Eve a destiny

Their new destiny was death

Genesis 3:19 In the sweat of your face shall you eat bread, till you return unto the ground; for out of it were you taken: for dust you are, and unto dust shall you return.


God wanted Adam and Eve to live in safety and security

Our Security got lost



God gave Adam and Eve desires, so He would eventually fulfill them

- The desires God has given us at creation are still there
- But: Because of sin, these desires are now longer fulfilled



God gave Adam and Eve desires, so He would eventually fulfill them

o Apart from God, we are now striving to earn again what was lost due to sin

The Result

- God's design isn't completely destroyed
- But Adam and Eve now have to deal with distortions that God never intended for them to face
- We are facing those same distortions

Spoiler Alert

- Sin added difficulties for us and detours to God's plan
- Nevertheless, we can be who God created Adam and Eve to be today!
 - We don't have to wait for heaven!

We have a Choice

- We live in our own brokenness, striving for what was lost in the fall
- Or we can live in God's Restoration
 - That's what we'll look at in the coming weeks
