Our Position


• We can look back at Christmas

• But the people who lived back then did not have this privilege of hindsight


400 Years of Silence

The Wise Men's Journey


Matthew 2:1 Now when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the king, behold, there came wise men from the east to Jerusalem,





The Biblical Pattern

- Following God means we have to spend a lot of time waiting

Just to be clear

- God is not late
- We are impatient

Galatians 5:22-23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, Meekness, self-control: against such there is no law.

David's Example

• David knew waiting isn't always a bad thing

Psalm 19:1-6 The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament shows his handiwork. Day unto day utters speech, and night unto night shows knowledge. There is no speech nor language, where their voice is not heard. Their line is gone out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world. In them has he set a tabernacle for the sun, Which is as a bridegroom coming out of his chamber, and rejoices as a strong man to run a race. Its going forth is from the end of the heaven, and its circuit unto the ends of it: and there is nothing hid from the heat thereof.

Our Problem


• When waiting on God, we are most tempted to take things into our own hands
