Types of Prayer

Matthew 6:9 After this manner therefore pray: Our Father who is in heaven, hallowed be your name.

- If I took an inventory of all my prayers over the last month: Which of the categories mentioned in today's sermon would be pretty full? What one would be pretty empty (or even completely empty)?
- How is the balance between „praying for my own life situation“ balanced with other types of prayer? Does God want me to make my adjustments?
- Do I treat „wants“ and „needs“ differently in my prayers? Do I sometimes treat wants like needs? Should I make some adjustments?
- What role does sin, repentance and forgiveness play in my prayer life? Do they confirm the Faith I profess?
- What role does „praying for others“ play in my regular prayer life?
- What adjustments does God want me to make in „praying all different types of prayer“?
