Forgiveness in Prayer

Matthew 18:35 So likewise shall my heavenly Father do also unto you, if you from your hearts forgive not everyone his brother their trespasses.

- Before today's sermon: How would I have defined forgiveness? Have I added something to the Biblical definition of forgiveness that made it more difficult to forgive?
- Have I ever had a personal encounter with the weight of my sin? Am I truly aware of how great my debt towards God was? Is it something I just know in my head? Or have I experienced the weight of my sin in my heart?
- Have I ever had a personal encounter with God's Forgiveness? Have I experienced the relief of knowing that the heavy burden of my sin has been removed? Would I say that „God's forgiveness has transformed my heart“?
- How do I generally treat others? Holding them accountable for what they did? Or being able to forgive them, based on the forgiveness I have received? Would other people agree with my self-assessment?
- Who do I need to forgive? What does God want me to do to be able to forgive this person? How does God want me to pray for myself or the other person in order to be able to forgive?
