



- Biblical Prayer is about "praying God's Will"


Prayer is telling God what He tells us to tell Him

Matthew 6:11 Give us this day our daily bread.


Different Ways of Praying

Matthew 6:11 Give us this day our daily bread.




Needs

- •




Just to be clear

- These things are not bad
- O God might give them to us
- But we cannot treat these things as needs!

Practically Speaking


- Praying for our needs

- He never promised to provide for tomorrow ahead of time
 - That's a want, but not a need

Matthew 6:11 Give us this day our daily bread.




Worry


Examining Ourselves

• Are there "wants" that we are treating as needs?




Examining Ourselves
