


Our Series: Prayer

Jesus' Authority


Matthew 28:18 And Jesus came and spoke unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

Jesus' Sacrifice

Ephesians 2:18 For through him we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father.

Romans 8:11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also bring to life your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwells in you.

John 14:12-14 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believes on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. And whatsoever you shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you shall ask anything in my name, I will do it.

John 15:7 If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, you shall ask what you will, and it shall be done unto you.

Mark 11:24 Therefore I say unto you, whatever things you desire, when you pray, believe that you will receive them, and you shall have them.


1 John 3:22 And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight.


Personal

- Hope and Assurance




Dealing with Problems

- Or we hand over our problems to God in prayer




The Empty Tomb

• I have total peace in the midst of very challenging circumstances




To Sum it all Up
